College Oration



1. Applicants should submit the full script of the oration.
2. The cover letter, addressed to the Honorary Secretary, should state the following.
 - a. Why the applicant believes that the work is of sufficient merit to deserve an oration
 - b. List of original papers and conference presentations (both oral and poster) of the applicant cited in the oration
 - c. In the case of multi-author research/publications,
 - i. the applicant's contribution to the design, data collection, analysis, and writing of publications/manuscripts.
 - ii. A declaration by the applicant that the other authors of the presented research have no objections to submitting the oration.
 - d. Declaration of financial and other conflicts of interest.
 - e. Declaration if a part of the work in the manuscript has already been presented as an oration.
3. It should not have been presented as an oration previously.
4. Three (3) hard copies of the oration should be submitted to

5. State 'Ethics Clearance' in the methods section for all research involving human or animal subjects.
6. Randomised Control Trials should have been registered in a WHO-recognized Clinical Trial Registry.
7. The oration should be typed using Times New Roman, size 12, double line spacing. Harvard or Vancouver's system of referencing can be used.
8. An electronic copy should be mailed to contactslcpsych@gmail.com AND Psychiatryslj@gmail.com
9. All authors of orations should be MEMBERS of the Sri Lanka College of Psychiatrists if they are eligible for membership. If you are not already a member, please become a member before forwarding your application.
10. The decision of the oration review committee will be final.
